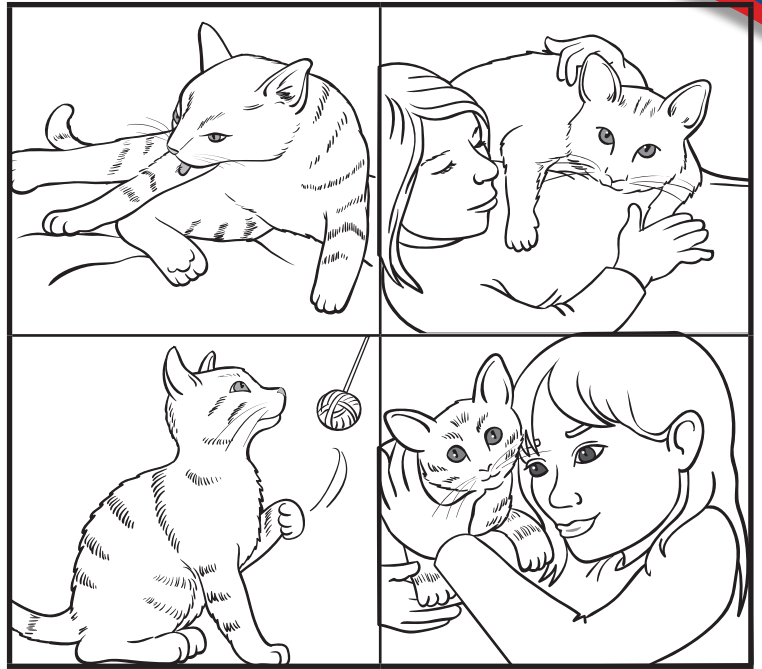


# Play Every Day!
