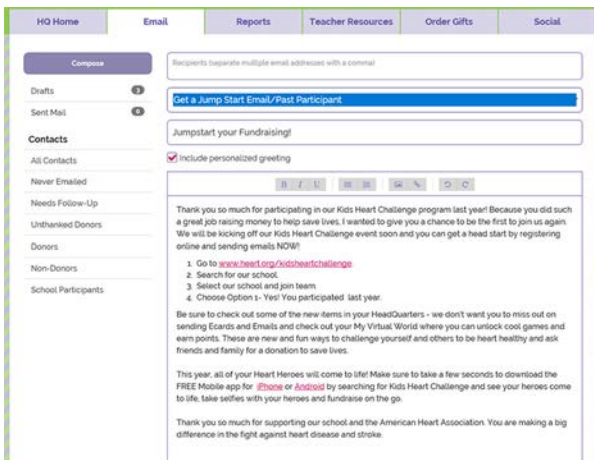

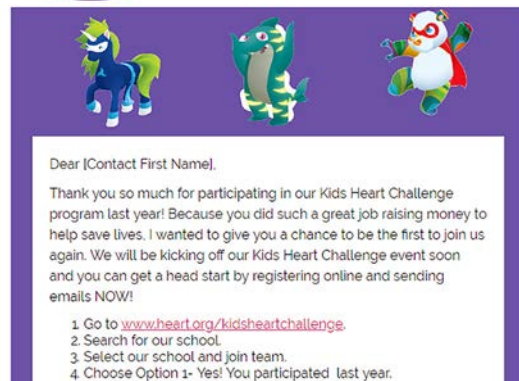



New this year, students/parents can **take a picture of their check in the app** and it will automatically update and deposit! You don't need to enter the checks and students should not submit them in their envelopes. If they do, please return them. These checks will show up in your E-Check column just like online donations.

4 All about gifts.

Need to see which gifts students will receive? Each student's card shows funds raised and the gifts he or she has earned. Once you distribute an instant gift, click on the icon and it will turn from gray to color for easy tracking. Or click on the **"Deliver All"** icon to take care of all of the student gifts at once. You can choose to view students' information as cards or in a grid.





To do a quick status check, use the menu at the top to sort students' information in the following ways:

- **Donation Summary**—see donations coming in online, in cash, by check, as E-Checks, or as matching gifts
- **Gift Summary**—see how many students have qualified for gifts at different levels
- **T-Shirt Summary**—see how many t-shirts you'll need, by size
- **Other Donations**—any miscellaneous cash, such as teacher donations and students who turned in coupons

5 Wrapping up.

All done? On your dashboard, click **"Submit"** in the Orders box. If additional funds come in after you've submitted your initial order, a new order will generate automatically when you click **"Manage Gifts."**



Your school may qualify for a School Thank-You Gift. If so, you will see the information on this page. You'll also see the Volunteer Thank-You Gift. You can choose to decline these gifts and funds will be used to fight heart disease and stroke.

To wrap up, fill in the date you will mail your order and any special instructions. Verify that the mailing address and email addresses are correct. Then go ahead and preregister for next year—you'll be one step ahead. Once you submit your order, print your summary and include it with your donation envelope. This year if you had more than one order you can print the orders together in one sheet.

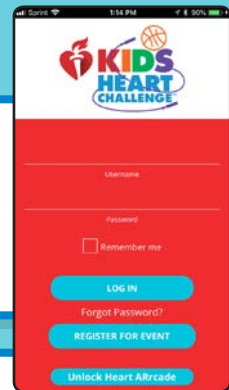
That's all there is to it!

After your donations and forms are received, it'll take about four weeks to receive thank-you gifts. To make distribution easier, gifts for each student who raised \$75 or more will be packaged in gift bundles and color coded for quick identification. All t-shirts are packaged separately and will need to be given out with the bundles.

Check your team goals, manage instant gifts, email participants, and watch the Heart Heroes come to life with our mobile app.

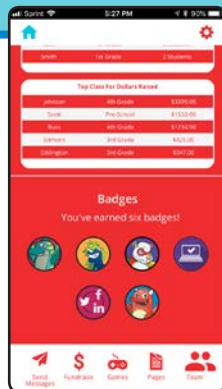



1 Download the app.

To find it, search “**Kids Heart Challenge**” in your app store. Then use your username and password to log in. (No username and password? Click “**Forgot Password?**”)

2 Manage your team’s event.

On this screen you’ll see your fundraising total and your team’s total. You’ll also see leaderboards and badges. **This year you can manage your event entirely from the mobile app.**

3 Explore what else you can do.

The icons at the bottom of the screen will guide you to lots of different options for managing your team’s event.



Choose various messages to send to your supporters. Send via email, social media, or text message. Click on **Schedule** to schedule social media messages. Click **eCard** to send heart-happy messages.



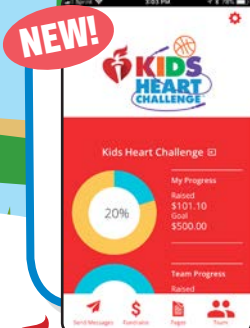
Visit the Heart ARcade to bring your Heart Heroes to life and create your own avatar.



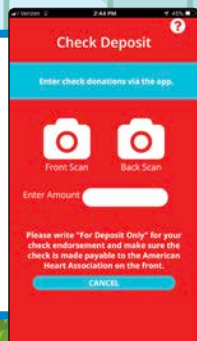
Keep track of funds you’ve raised and enter donations.



Edit your personal fundraising page and then share the page, upload an image, or view the page.



Change your goal right on the main screen.



Students can take a picture of their donors’ checks. Once they do, the checks will be deposited and students won’t need to include them in their envelopes. You can take pictures of your own donors’ checks too (but not students’ donor checks).



Show students how to scan their wristband, kickoff stickers, mid-event tattoo, and Heart Heroes and watch them come to life. They can even take selfies with their favorite Heart Heroes!

Print Your Team Participant Report

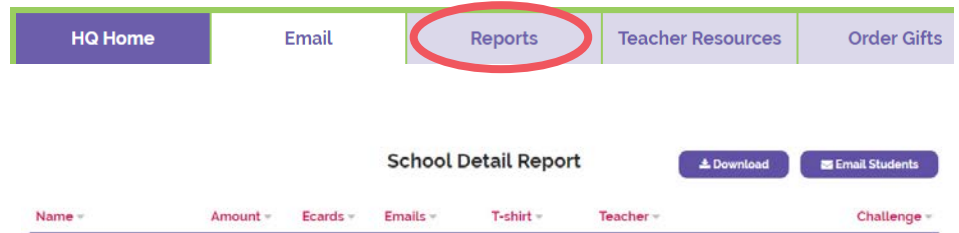

Get your report.

Click on the purple **"Reports"** tab at the top of the page. You can review the information and sort by contributor name, amount, number of ecards sent, number of emails sent, t-shirt size, teacher name, or heart-happy challenge.

Print the report.

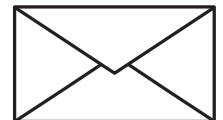
Select **"Download."** The report will download to your computer as a CSV file. (CSV files look similar to Excel, but you don't have to have Excel to view them.) Can't find it? Check your browser settings or type Control + J, which works in several popular browsers to show your downloads.

- ♥ Set your fundraising goal.

You're registered! You'll see a message inviting you to go to your own fundraising page and Heart Heroes Virtual World.

Send emails and ecards to challenge friends and family to follow heart-happy habits.

- ♥ On your Headquarters page, look at the Email Challenge box at the top right. Choose whether you want to send emails or ecards.
- ♥ Follow the directions and add the email addresses that your parents gave permission for you to contact.
- ♥ Set a goal to send at least 10 emails or ecards.

That's it! Sending ecards and emails helps you spread heart-happy messages, raise lifesaving funds, and unlock fun surprises in your Heart Heroes Virtual World. With help from a parent or guardian, you can also use social media and text messaging to share heart-happy messages and raise funds.

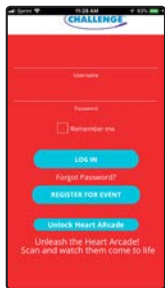
Check your goals, see what gifts you've earned, email donors, play games, and watch the Heart Heroes come to life, all with this handy mobile app.

Scan your Heart Hero from the main screen. No need to log in!



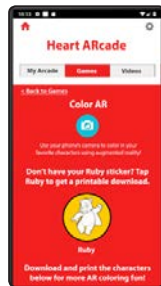
What else can you scan? Try your sticker, envelope, tattoo, wristband, keychain, t-shirt, or plush. Your Heart Heroes will dance, jump and play.



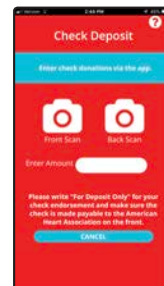

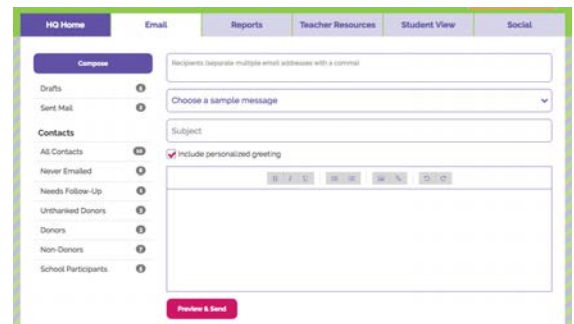
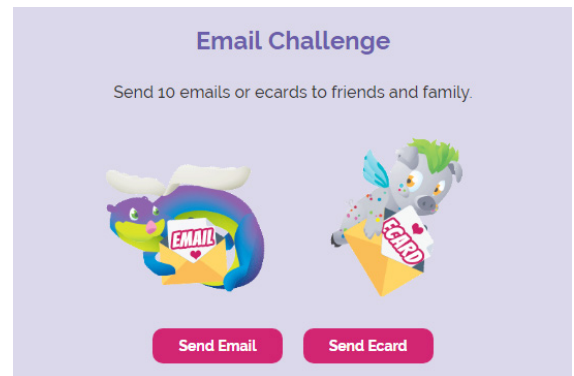
