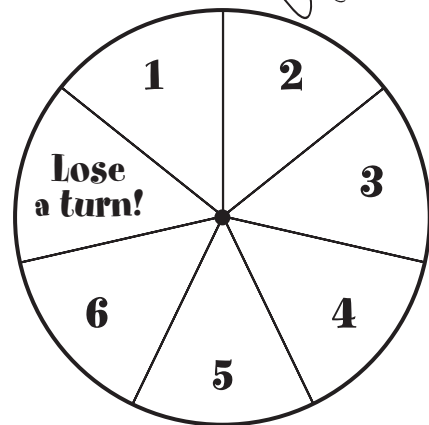


Shape Smash

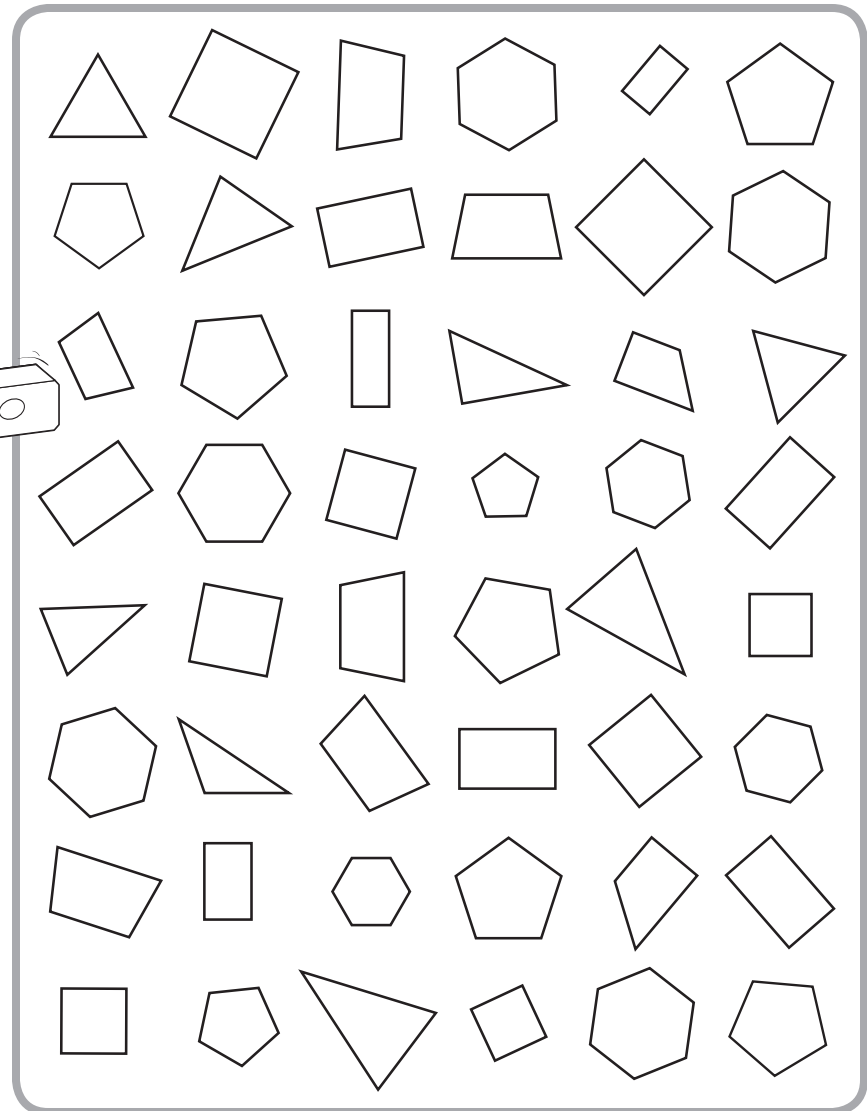
Directions for two players:

1. Choose a crayon. Pick a different color than your partner.
2. When it's your turn, use the paper clip and a pencil to spin the spinner. Read the matching clue.
3. Say the name of the shape that matches the clue. Point to a matching shape on the gameboard.
4. Have your partner check your answer on the key.
 If it is correct, color the space.
 If it is incorrect, your turn is over.
5. The player with more colored shapes at the end of play wins.



Clues

- 1 = 3 sides, 3 corners
- 2 = 4 equal sides, 4 corners
- 3 = 2 pairs of equal-length sides
- 4 = 4 sides, 1 set of parallel sides
- 5 = 5 sides, 5 corners
- 6 = 6 sides, 6 corners
